Australia's Outreach Efforts

- Asia Pacific Counter-Proliferation Outreach Program (CPOP)
- Outreach as Chair of the Australia Group, Wassenaar Arrangement
- Regional Security of Radioactive Sources Program
- Regional and like-minded country efforts
- PSI outreach – Pacific Protector 06



Australia's Approach to Counter-Proliferation Outreach



- Three principles:
 - tailored to needs, following consultation
 - areas of Australian expertise / value adding
 - complement rather than duplicate other efforts
- Methodology:
 - scoping visit ⇒ understanding CP system
 - ⇒ discussing needs ⇒ tailored workshops
 - ⇒ targeted follow-up



Australian Counter-Proliferation Outreach Activities



- scoping visits to and consultations with most major supplier or transshipment countries
- targeted technical assistance workshops:
 - already in Thailand, Singapore, Cambodia, the Philippines, and the UAE
 - workshops planned for Vietnam, Indonesia and other regional countries



Australian Counter-Proliferation Outreach Activities



- Ministerial-level regional nuclear safeguards and security conference in November 2005,
- Asian Export Controls Policy Dialogue in February 2006
- Seminar in Beijing on Implementation of UNSCR 1540 in July 2006.



Australian Counter-Proliferation Outreach Activities



- Collaboration with the US and Japan:
 - counter-proliferation and safeguards (Thailand)
 - commodity identification of dual-use goods (Singapore).
- Australian contributions to:
 - Effective Elements for Export Controls for APEC Economies Conference (Honolulu)
 - ASEAN Regional Forum Export Licensing Experts Meeting (Singapore)



Case Study: The Philippines



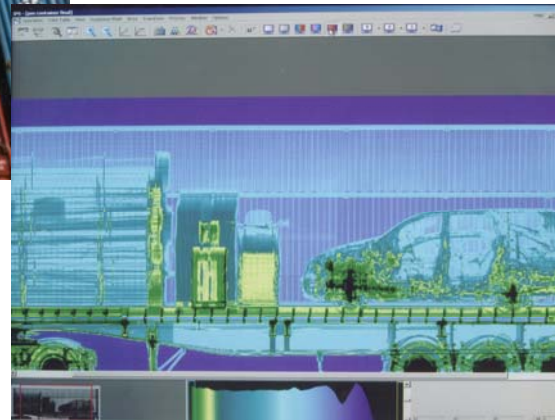
- Scoping visit
