What does Goods Checker do?

- It helps exporters decide whether their goods, software or technology are controlled by UK or EC strategic export control legislation.
- By entering keywords that describe their goods, the exporter can search against the current UK Strategic Export Control lists to find the Control List entry, or entries, which apply.

Who can use Goods Checker and where can I find it?

- Anyone, but users must register before they can use the search functions.
- A few minutes after registering you will be e-mailed a password.

Can I see anything about Good Checker on the website without registering?

- You can look at *What it's About, How it Works* and *Quick Help*, which is a short user manual that gives guidance on how to use the tool, without registering.

I can't find my goods, software or technology using Good Checker so presumably they don't require an export licence.

- Not necessarily so -

- You may not have run the correct search or may be searching on the wrong type of keyword e.g. a product brand or trade name.
- End-use controls can also apply to goods that are not listed.
- Guidance on effective searches is given in Quick Help.

Reasons for control

Carbon-carbon is a material used in components that must withstand the effects of high temperature and ablation in military and civilian space launch vehicles, spacecraft and rockets. Typical components made of this material are rocket motor exit cones and nozzles, reentry vehicle nosetips, and heat shields. Carbon-carbon is also used in military and civilian aircraft applications requiring high strength and low weight, such as wing roots, and in high temperature tooling, such as pouring ladles for steel.
