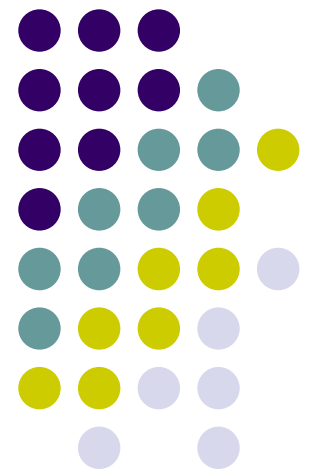
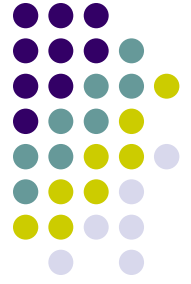

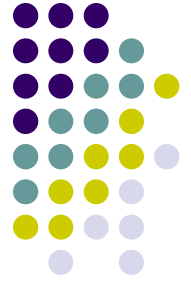

- Stressed importance of international norms and standards



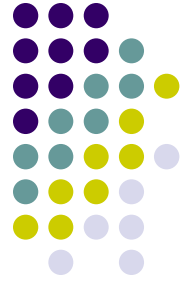
# Policy Breakout Group

- Need to adapt to individual political, economic, and social circumstances



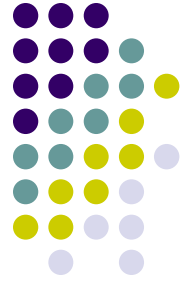
# Policy Breakout Group

# Policy Breakout Group

- Tensions between export control and trade promotion
- But controls will make states and businesses more attractive trading partners
- Overall, participants expressed readiness to promote enhanced export controls within their governments
