Nonproliferation Training Activities

- Visiting Fellow Programs – More than 100 Fellows
 - Junior and mid-level diplomats and academics
 - Russia and former Soviet Republics
 - China
 - Non-Aligned States (Sri Lanka, Indonesia, others)
 - 10-12 weeks' training in Monterey, CA
 - Lectures
 - Mentored research leading to paper and presentation
 - 5-day visit to Washington, DC

Export Control Training Activities

- PRC Visiting Fellows
 - 8-9 weeks in Monterey + 3 weeks Univ. of Georgia Center for Int'l Trade Security+5 days in Washington - 24 fellows to date
- In Central Asia, Middle East
 - Multi-day seminars
 - Wide range of international officials, specialists as speakers
 - Focused on either biological and chemical weapons or nuclear weapons
- Globally
 - UN-sponsored events supporting implementation of Security Council Resolution 1540
